AUSTRALIAN SQUAD SELECTION & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (JUNIOR/COLT/SENIOR/MASTER) for SKI AUSTRALIAN TEAM 2009

- Australian Team Members who competed at the World Cup in Toyko, Japan 2006 automatically qualify for the Australian Squad but, must still meet the ongoing criteria stated below to gain selection on the Team.
 - Other candidates must be put forward by their Instructor to the State Coach and T & D Representative. It is the responsibility of both the State Coach and T & D Representative to screen the candidate for past competition performance, current standard and potential to compete at International level. (The Australian Squad should not be used for the sole purpose of gaining experience)
 - All candidates must believe they have the financial ability to meet travel costs. In the case of Juniors (under 18 years) each Member must be chaperoned by a parent/guardian.
 - Members must complete and return the Australian Squad Registration & Application Form that follows to Australian Head Coach prior to Shotokan Week 2007.
 - In order to qualify for final selection members must attain 20 points before Shotokan Week 2008. Points can be earned in the following manner;
 - 10 Points for attending Shotokan Week 2007
 - 5 Points for attending 2 day Australian/Assistant Coach training seminar (8 hours)
 - 2 Points for entering a recognised competition (SKIA/AKF/NAS)
 - 3 Points for 1st place
 - 2 Points for 2nd place
 - 1 Point for 3rd place
- Note:** Points for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place can only be earned in the category (Individual Kata &/or Kumite and, Team Kata) a squad member has nominated on his/her "Registration & Application for Selection" form (Team Kumite does not apply). Further, attaining the 20 points (or more) simply qualifies you for final selection* – it does not mean you will automatically earn a spot on the Australian Team in your respective category.
- This means Shotokan Week 2007 is not compulsory but nominated/registered Squad Members should endeavour to attend and compete in more competitions to improve skills and experience. All competition results will be taken into account in accordance with the prescribed point system.
 - Squad Members must maintain Training Programs and submit the same to Coaches on request. One must also include specific training drills provided by Coaches into their training programs.
 - Squad Members must fulfil any other reasonable requirement by the Coaches which is determined to be beneficial to an individual squad member's preparation, development and/or the team's.
 - The Australian Team to compete at the next World Cup will be selected by the Coaches during Shotokan Week 2008 and announced after the Australian Championships at the end of that week. Therefore, ***Shotokan Week 2008 is compulsory to gain selection.**
 - If a squad member becomes aware he/she is not able to fulfil any or all the criteria then, it is his/her duty and responsibility to inform the Coaches immediately. Withdrawal after final selection without a valid reason will not be viewed favourably.

It is each Squad Members responsibility to read, understand, meet and adhere to the above criteria. If you have any questions or reservations then discuss with your State Coach, T & D Representative and/or Australian Coaches.

Please be advised that a squad member will seriously jeopardise their chance of selection on the Australian Team if he/she does not fulfil and adhere to the above criteria. Evidence of sickness or injury will of course be given consideration but any obvious disregard or disrespect for the above criteria may result in the squad member being dismissed.
